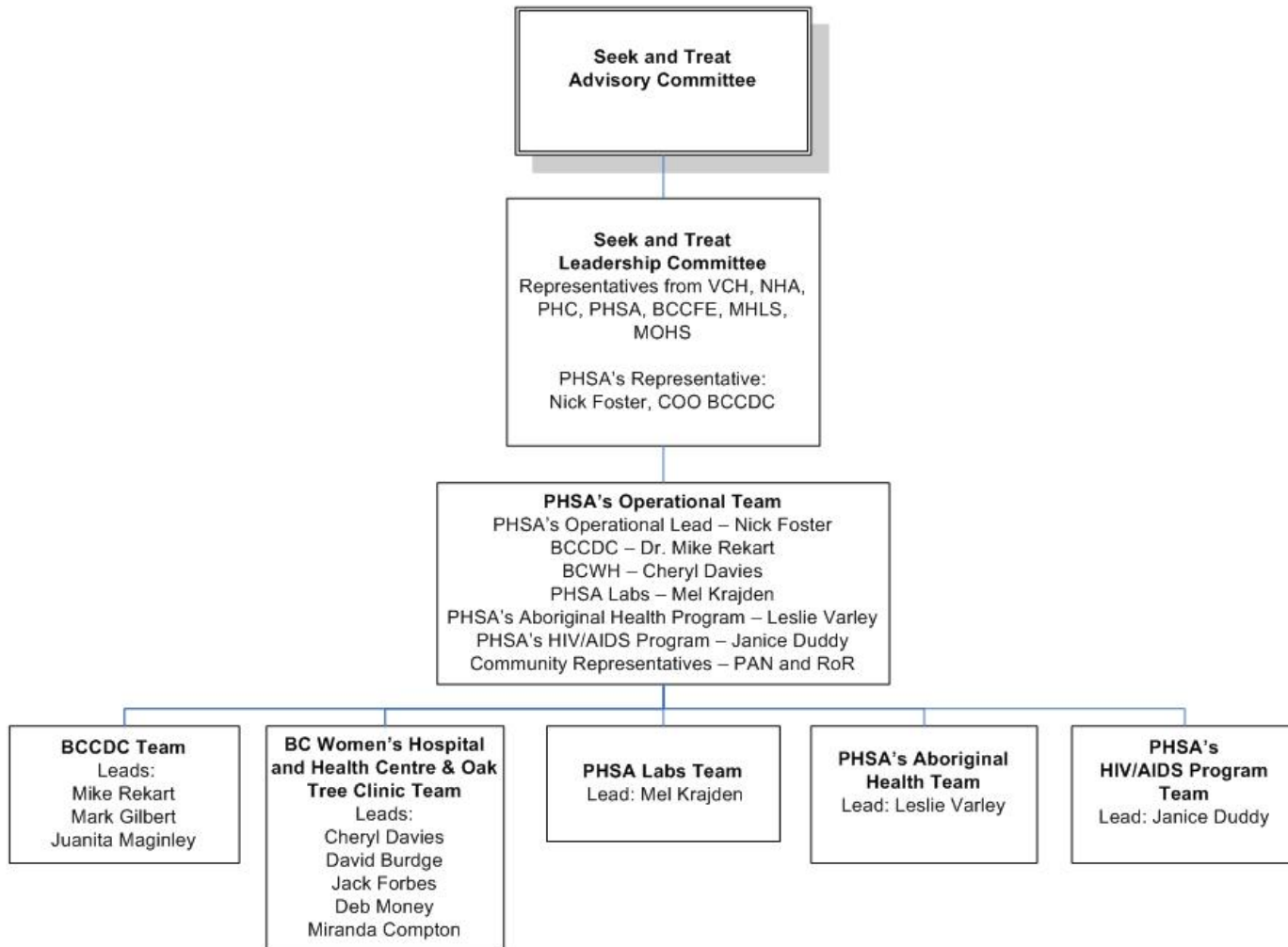

PHSA's STOP HIV/AIDS BUDGET

- 2009/2010 - \$180,000
- 2010/2011 - \$360,000
- 2011/2012 - \$1,640,000
- 2012/2013 - \$1,640,000

STOP Goal One: To reduce HIV/AIDS cases in Prince George and Vancouver Inner City

- Overall outcome for the STOP HIV/AIDS Pilot Project – all other goals are working to fulfill this

STOP GOAL TWO: To Improve the effectiveness of HIV screening and early detection

- PHSA Laboratories –
 - support increase in HIV and ancillary testing in pilot sites
 - develop provincial POC testing program
- Surveillance and Informatics – BCCDC and PHSA Labs:
 - Describe stage of infection in person diagnosed with HIV
 - Use HCV and STI case and testing data as a marker for high-risk behaviour for HIV
 - Develop recommendation on how best to strategically target HIV testing in pilot regions

STOP GOAL THREE: To ensure timely access to high-quality and safe HIV/AIDS care and treatment

- BC Women's Hospital and Health Centre and Oak Tree Clinic will:
 - Provide clinical education sessions to share standards of care within a women/family-centered framework
 - Expand role for nurse practitioners in care and treatment
 - Enhance clinical and support services at Oak Tree Clinic (0.5 FTE social worker, increase in physician time by 2 days/week)
 - Support outreach to Alouette Correctional Centre – discharge planning
 - Develop recommendations for a women-centered service delivery model

GOAL FOUR: To improve the patient experience in every step of the HIV/AIDS journey

- PHSA's Aboriginal Health Program will
 - Provide online Indigenous Cultural Competency course to all leadership and staff working on STOP initiative

GOAL FIVE: To demonstrate system and cost optimization

- PHSA Laboratories will:
 - Project and track laboratory costs related to STOP HIV/AIDS

OVERARCHING STRATEGIES

- BC Women's Hospital
 - Conducting a community consultation with positive women
 - Provide sex and gender-based analysis training for STOP leadership and partners
- PHSA's HIV/AIDS Program and Aboriginal Health Program
 - Support the Aboriginal community engagement strategy in partnership with Aboriginal representatives on STOP Leadership Committee
